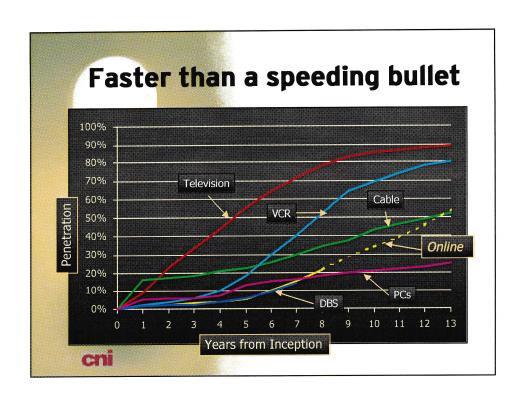

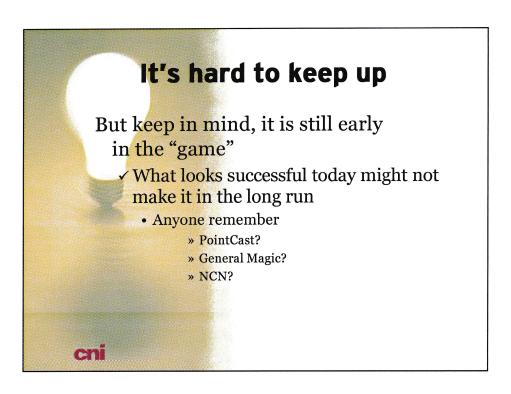

Driving people from online to offline Online coupons

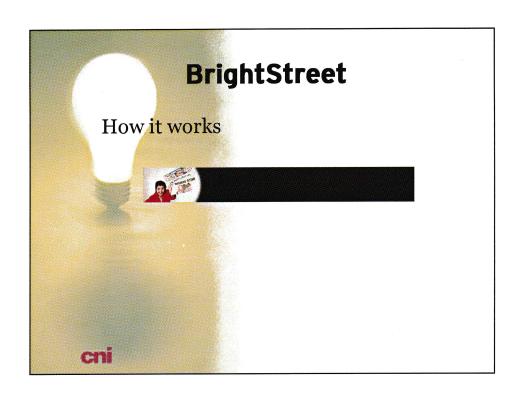
- ✓ Adds "sticky application" to the site
- ✓ Drives feet to the brick & mortar store

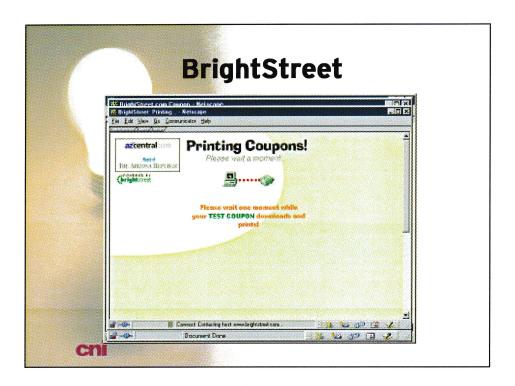

Emerging tool: Audio

Some statistics

- ✓ 63% of online customers know that you can listen to audio programming
 - Half of those have tried it
 - Online audio audience has increased to 14% today from 6% in August 1998

Unlike radio, Web site controls the "commercials" and/or sponsorships

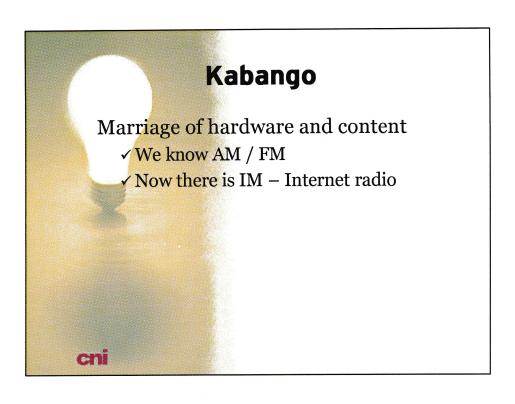
- ✓ With Real Audio radio stations, sites just provide another delivery method
 - No share in the station's revenue

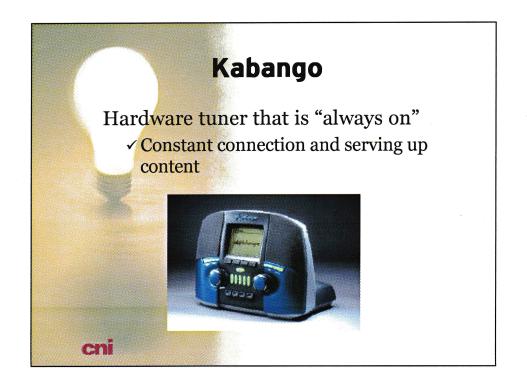

- ✓ 500 million WAP-enabled phones in 2003

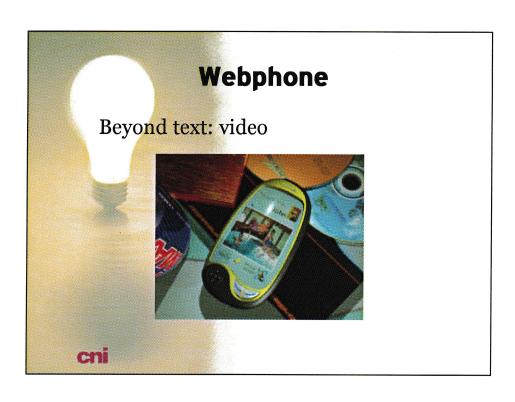

 - Web browsing and IP phone calls

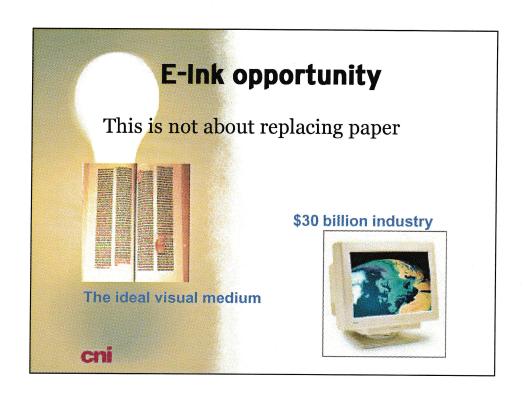


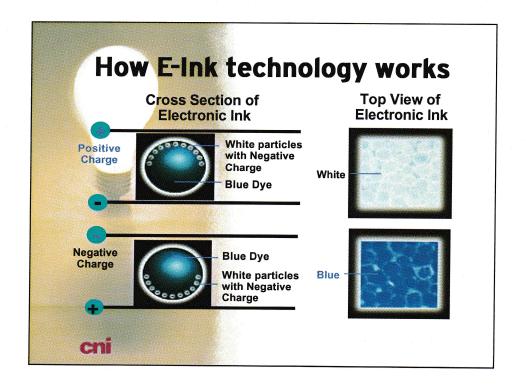


Emerging tool: Electronic ink

E-Ink is here

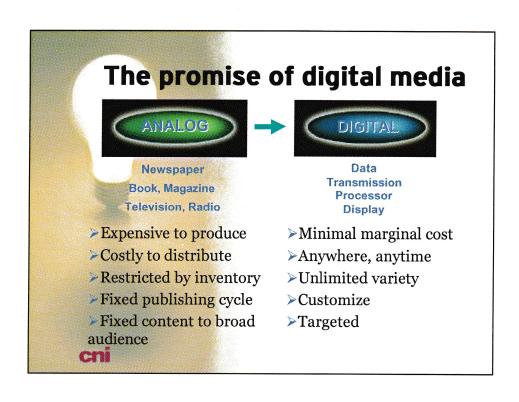
- ✓ Sounds a bit like science fiction, but it is real
 - Full of opportunities and dangers



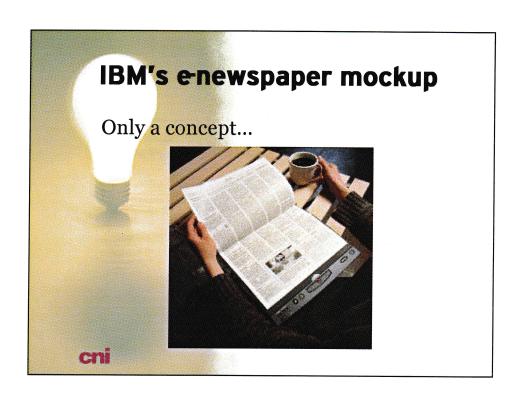
